UCSB Department of English Undergraduate Independent Research Assistance English 199RA

The English 199RA Independent Research Assistance Course gives qualified undergraduates a chance to assist in a faculty research project. The 199RA is designed not only to forward participating instructors' interests, but also to give students significant research experience beyond what would be received in an ordinary undergraduate course.

For each four-unit 199RA course expect to do 10-12 hours of work per week, including a one-hour meeting with the instructor and a significant amount of reading and writing. Professors actively seeking assistants will include a description of their projects with the College of Letters and Science Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities (URCA) office. Their web site is http://www.ltsc.ucsb.edu/urca. Announcements will be made on the English Undergraduate Listserv also.

If there is a faculty member who has not advertised, but whose area of interest corresponds to yours, ask if an assistant needed. To find regular faculty members' areas of specialization, visit the staff undergraduate adviser, or the faculty information sites on the department pages at www.english.ucsb.edu.

Before enrolling in English 199RA, you must have met the following requirements!

- 1. Overall Grade Point Average (GPA) must be at least 3.0 for the preceding three quarters.
- 2. At least 84 units must have been completed overall.
- 3. At least two upper-division English courses must have been completed, one of which should be relevant to the subject to be studied.

Exceptions to the above requirements to be made only with faculty sponsor, undergraduate chair, and College of Letters & Science approval.

Students are limited to five (5) units *per quarter* and 30 units for *all* 98/99 and 198/199/199RA courses combined. A maximum of eight (8) units of 199/199RA may apply toward the English major.

Approval for a 199RA cannot be rushed and is to be completed in the quarter <u>before</u> the project is begun.

Do not start the project without full approval <u>and</u> an add-code so you can register for the course!!!
